

VILLAGE OF WYANET BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING AUGUST 12, 2025

Village President, Jim Blanford, called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Following the pledge of allegiance roll call was answered by Blanford, Johnson, Law, E. Sproul and M. Sproul. Wood was absent.

Kim Rich, representing the Community Club, discussed the Christmas lights, the tennis court and drainage on S. West St.

Ron Starr requested the board drop the ordinance violation against him.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by E. Sproul to drop the ordinance violation against Ron and Linda Starr, the current property owners of 209 S. King St. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote. Wood was absent.

Ken Brummel, from Sheffield reported about an ongoing project to combine 5 rescue units into one to be located at Route 40.

Village Engineer, Jack Kusek, reported that bids had come in too high for the street program. He suggested increasing the project to make it more appealing to contractors. Concerns were voiced about proceeding this late in the summer.

A motion was made by E. Sproul and seconded by M. Sproul to approve a **Resolution** for the overage for a total of \$87,835.52. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote. Wood was absent.

A motion was made by E. Sproul and seconded by Johnson to approve a supplemental **Resolution** in the amount of \$34,000.00. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote. Wood was absent.

President Blanford gave the monthly police report.

He also, presented the monthly maintenance report. The superintendent has been busy with mowing, 2 burials, repaired a leak on North St. and bypassed excessive water at sewer plant, along with regular maintenance duties.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by E. Sproul to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote. Wood was absent.

Committee Reports:

Ordinance & Board of Health- the board discussed repeat violators of the weed and grass ordinance.

Water, Sewer and Finance- the recent distributed public letter was discussed. A suggestion was brought up to check on possible free postage for mailings.

Equipment, Parks & Historical- they are looking for a new trash pump.

Old Business: A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by E. Sproul to appoint Elwood Partain to fill the vacant trustee seat. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote. Wood was absent.

A motion was made by E. Sproul and seconded by M Sproul to hire Eran Salzman as maintenance worker with starting pay at \$25.00 per hour. E. Sproul, M. Sproul and Johnson voted in favor of the motion. Law voted no. Wood was absent. Motion passed

New Business:

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by M. Sproul to approve the **Resolution** to approve content/release of closed session minutes. Motion passed by roll call vote.
