

## VILLAGE OF WYANET BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING NOVEMBER 11, 2025

Village President Jim Blanford called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Following the pledge of allegiance roll call was answered by Blanford, Johnson, Law, Partain, E. Sproul, M. Sproul and Wood.

Village resident Kim Rich voiced concerns about drainage on S. West St., her neighbors covered well, speeding on S. West St. and the Community Clubs Christmas lights.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Law to accept the Community Clubs Christmas lights. Motion passed by roll call vote.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by M. Sproul to rent a lift and hang the lights on poles with electricity. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Rich acknowledged that by the village completing the Community Clubs commitment to donate the Christmas lights after installation fulfills the village's offer to donate \$3000.

Village Attorney, Jacob Frost, explained the procedure for the foreclosure sale of 730 Canal St. to be held on Nov. 20<sup>th</sup> at 10:00 a.m.

Bruce Hand offered to assist with electrical work for the water plant and in hanging the Christmas lights.

President Blanford gave the monthly maintenance report. Along with regular maintenance duties the employees completed cemetery clean up, winterized the park twice due to rescheduling by the Community Club. Spray patching and crack sealing have been completed.

President Blanford also, gave the monthly police report. The police department has done 4 traffic stops, issued 2 citations and had 1 ambulance assist for the month of October. He handed out trick or treat candy, registered a sex offender and issued 1 trespass warning.

### **Committee Reports:**

Equipment, Parks & Historical– Trustee Law asked about possibly using speed cameras to control speeding on some streets.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by E. Sproul to approve the consent agenda with corrections. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

A motion was made by E. Sproul and seconded by M. Sproul to approve of Bruce Hand helping with various electrical projects. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

### **Old Business:**

Attorney Frost will proceed with re-advertising the property at 308 S. Walnut after the 6 month waiting period unless an offer is received in that time period.

### **New Business:**

Attorney Frost explained the procedure for vacating a portion of North St. A hearing will be held on January 13, 2026, at the Village Hall.

A motion was made by M. Sproul and seconded by Partain to bid up to \$36,200 for the property at 730 Canal St. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

No objection was voiced for the Variation request by Larry Klingenberg.

The December board meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. with pizza to follow at approximately 7:00p.m.

Trustee Law submitted a letter of resignation as trustee. No action was taken.

A motion was made by E. Sproul and seconded by Johnson to adjourn the meeting at 8:57 p.m. Motion passed unanimously by voice vote.
