

VILLAGE OF WYANET BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING JANUARY 13, 2026

President Blanford called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Following the pledge of allegiance roll call was answered by Blanford, Johnson, Partain, E. Sproul, M. Sproul and Wood.

Adam Bradley and Marcella Nordstrom addressed the board concerning the notice they had received about cargo containers. They asked if they had gotten the only notice or if other notices had been distributed pertaining to the nuisance ordinance. According to the ordinance there are several violations on their street.

Bruce Hand asked the board had any information about conducting a business in a residential district and inquired about loading and unloading trailers in the street/ROW.

Attorney Jacob Frost informed the board that Clarence Brown would be making payments on his fines. The board can file a new suit if they wish to.

President Blanford gave the monthly maintenance report. The workers have continued to have snow plow issued with the windshield. They completed several Julie locates, taken Christmas lights down and built storage racks in the garage for them and replaced one valve in the water plant along with regular maintenance items.

Blanford also, gave the monthly police report. He did 5 traffic stops, 1 ambulance assist, 1 key locked in a vehicle, 1 dog at large complaint and 2 parking complaints that he's still working on.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by E. Sproul to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

Committee Reports:

Water-sewer & Finance- there has not been any new information about the lead service line grant

Equipment, Parks & Historical-there are still issues with the snow plow throwing snow up onto the windshield

Vacating a portion of East North Street will not be pursued any further. That portion of the street was incorrectly added by the tax mapping department at the court house and is not Village property

A motion was made to appoint Bruce Hand to fill the vacant board seat. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.
