

VILLAGE OF WYANET BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING APRIL 15, 2026

Board President Jim Blanford called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Following the pledge of allegiance roll call was answered by Blanford, Hand, Johnson, Partain, E. Sproul, M. Sproul and Wood.

Kyle Vander Meersch of Rossy's requested the renewal of their liquor license.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by M. Sproul to renew the liquor license for Rossy's contingent on a notary stamp. They provided payment for the past due balance for 2025 and the payment for the first half of 2026. Motion passed unanimously by roll call vote.

President Blanford gave the monthly maintenance report. They have been cleaning storm drains, digging a ditch behind the shop at the sewer plant to direct rainwater away from the building, patching pot holes, flushed fire hydrants, completed cemetery clean up, replaced the fire hydrant at the corner of 5th St. and South West St.

President also, gave the monthly police report. He did 12 traffic stops with 7 verbal warnings and 5 citations and 2 ambulance assists.
