

VILLAGE OF WYANET BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING JULY 23, 2026

Village President Jim Blanford called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Following the pledge of allegiance roll call was answered by Blanford, Hand, Johnson, Partain, E. Sproul, M. Sproul and Wood.

Jack Kusek, Village Engineer reported that bids for the street maintenance project will be opened August 3rd.

President Blanford gave the maintenance report. The maintenance department requested that the board not agree to any street work after September 30th. They have been busy mowing, weed eating the cemetery every other week, park rentals, stained the ball diamond dugouts, lead sampling, trimming trees, marking streets for spray patching and regular daily maintenance duties.
